

JUST CHARLIE



After first writing "just charlie" on mix tapes distributed in Washington D.C. in the late 1990's, the name stuck.

Almost 15 years later, Just Charlie is in Asia opening for the likes of DJ Shadow and DJ Krush. Meanwhile, he's holding down his own crew Disco Death and creating breakthrough new events in China like DOJO while still performing all around China.

A turntablist from the beginning of his DJ career, Just Charlie switched to Serato upon its release in 2005 and since then has grown to become a multi-genre DJ known to span a dozen musical styles in a single night. Scratching and mixing while deftly maneuvering through disparate and unpredictable styles of music is where Just Charlie truly shines.



Musical styles:

- Golden age & modern hip hop
- Drum & bass, trap, moombahton
- Soul, reggae, funk
- Chicago house, Baltimore Club

Over his 14 year DJ career he's recorded and released over 20 mix tapes, 10 of which are available for free download on his website. Over the last decade they've together accrued over 25,000 downloads. In addition to creating mix tapes, Just Charlie has produced music for some of China's most prominent rappers, including Kafe Hu, one of mainland China's rising rap stars also hailing from Chengdu. In 2012, the Just Charlie & Kafe Hu collaboration "Urban Youth" was featured on BBC's Radio 1.
